Photography contest is held during the November general meeting and all photographs must be submitted prior to the start of the meeting. Please try to submit them 15 minutes prior to the start of the general meeting as this will make it easier on those setting up the photography contest.

Contest Categories:

- Single Flower
- Multi Flower
- Miscellaneous
- Additional Categories that may be judged:
 - Judges' Choice
 - Peoples' Choice

General rules:

- You must be a member of the San Diego Epiphyllum Society to enter
- You must be the originator of the photographs
- Photograph must be of epiphyllum hybrid or epiphytic cacti species
- You are limited to a total of no more than ten (10) photographs in the contest
- Photograph must feature a named hybrid, species, or if a seedling the parentage must be known
 - Photographs with misnamed hybrid or species will be disqualified. (For example; label photograph as 'Clown' but it is not 'Clown' will not be judged)
- Photographs may or may not be matted but ***they must not be framed***
- **Size of photographs :**
 - minimum size of 4" x 6"
 - maximum of 8" x 10"

Entry Identification Requirements on the back of your photograph write:

- Your first and last name.
- Your email address (if you have one)
- Your telephone number
- The name of flower or parentage, if it is a seedling.

Awards and Recognition:

- Ribbons (Blue-1st, Red-2nd, White-3rd), and honorable mention will be awarded in the Single Flower and Multi Flower categories
- Honorable mention will be awarded in the Miscellaneous category
- Ribbons may also be awarded for "People's Choice" and "Judges' Choice" categories
- Winning photographs will be published in Epi News, Society's website, and may be used in the Society's social media and promotional material.
- First place winners of the Single and Multi-flower categories will also be featured as a cover photograph of *Epi News*

Use of Contest Photographs and Miscellaneous information.

- By entering this contest you consent to having your photograph published in the SDES's newsletter, website and social media.
- Any photographs that do not meet the rules of the single and multi-flower categories will be moved to the miscellaneous category. (For example; unknowns, framed photographs, and Photoshopped photographs)
