Your photographs are invaluable in supporting the mission of the San Diego Epiphyllum Society. We are deeply grateful for your contribution to our mission and fellowship through your photography.

If your photograph was accepted into the contest and was not in a digital format, you authorize SDES to make a digital copy of the submitted photograph.

You will retain all rights except as stated below to all photographs you submit. When you submit a photograph to the San Diego Epiphyllum Society, you grant The San Diego Epiphyllum Society a royalty-free nonexclusive right in perpetuity to:

- Use photographs in San Diego Epiphyllum Society's internet and social media related to support of our mission.
- Use the photograph in The San Diego Epiphyllum Society's internal and external communications materials, including but not limited to websites and web publications, fact sheets, fundraising publications, advertising, multimedia, presentation and membership services, annual reports and San Diego Epiphyllum Society magazine or newsletter.
- Provide your photograph to other individuals and organizations for use in news stories, newsletters, reports, slide shows, displays, web pages, videos, membership premiums, etc., related to the San Diego Epiphyllum Society.
- Use, in connection with the Photo Contest, your name, and country of residence in promotions and other publications.
- Use of photograph in the San Diego Epiphyllum Society Bloom Catalog.
- Retain a digital copy of your photograph that will be archived in the Society's photo library and/or catalog and made accessible to Society staff via the Society's internal online photo archive or bloom catalog.
- Allow third parties to share the photograph on social media platforms such as Twitter, Facebook, and Pinterest only when used to promote the San Diego Epiphyllum Society.

The San Diego Epiphyllum Society will endeavor to credit specific photographs to the photographer all external publications. Notable exceptions are where where credit would subtract from a San Diego Epiphyllum Society webpage, or brochure design and the Bloom Catalog.
